## CALL TO LOCAL ARTISTS: Art Walk 2018

**Deadline: July 20, 2018**

The Pembina Hills Arts Council, on behalf of the Morden Corn and Apple Festival, invites local artists to apply to participate in the annual Art Walk artist demonstration. The goal of this project is to demonstrate the many talented artists who live in our Pembina Valley Region, while engaging the public in some hands-on arts demonstrations and interactive learning.

Artists will be selected to fill 12 afternoon time slots. The purpose of Art Walk is to demonstrate and engage the public over the festival days (August 24, 25 & 26, 2018). Artists will be selected to occupy one or more 4-hour slots during the festival days. We have four locations to fill: a tent at Confederation Park and three available at the Pembina Hill Arts Centre.

### Submission Requirements:

- Artist Statement (one-page max)
- Project Description (one-page max)
- How will your project engage the public?
  - What project will they help you with? Is it a group project or an individual project?
  - You should expect 30 – 50 participants per day. Can your project sustain this?
  - Are there any safety concerns?
  - Anything else we should know?
- You are welcome to submit up to five images along with your submission for promotional purposes
- Detailed list of supplies required for effective community engagement (max \$100)
